## **Program Information**

Tri-County RVTHS Continuing Education partnering with Masshire & Commonwealth Corp. is proud to offer three no cost instructional programs focusing on the target sector of HVAC&R, Carpentry, and CNC Operator/Certified Welding programs. These programs will provide the accepted students the following essential skill sets

- Hands On Instruction
- Practical/Theory Instruction
- Career Readiness Skills

## **Admission Requirements**

Applicants will need to be:

- MA Resident
- 18 years of age
- Physically capable to perform construction related tasks aligned with the program
- Complete an online application

**Courses start the week of January 16, 2023 and will run 2-4 nights a week from 4-9pm.**

## **Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning & Refrigeration**

Participants will learn the processes involved in installing, repairing, and troubleshooting essential heating, cooling, and refrigeration systems. Students will also gain hours that can be applied to obtaining a refrigeration license. Students in the program will also learn the fundamentals needed to develop the material, equipment lists, and elementary estimating skills to help them obtain a position as an HVAC/R technician, parts salesperson, and installer for various types of energy related industries.

## **CNC Operator/Certified Welder**

Participants learn and develop the techniques needed to become a metal fabricator. Through CNC Technology, they will utilize the Computer Network Controlled (CNC) Plasma cutter to design and cut custom metal works. Students will also learn and develop the skills required to prepare for an American Welding Society (AWS) Certification, and submit their work for certification. This will help prepare students for the many different aspects of the welding and manufacturing industry.

## **Carpentry**

Participants in this program will learn how to layout and frame both wood and metal structures. This will include sheathing, siding, roofing, and trim to create a weather tight building envelope. Students will also learn the elements of commercial construction including layout, framing, drywall interior finishes and suspended ceiling systems.
